## Risk Assessment Scoring

Severity	Exposure/ Probability

Red - Unreasonable Risks

Score is the multiplication of Severity and Exposure

## Risk Rating

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please consider any controls in place when scoring the hazard (i.e. this fact could reduce scales below in at least one point)

### Severity Scale description - What could happen?

- 1 No Injury
- 2 Injury that could lead to first aid treatment on-site
- 3 Injury that could lead to lost work days
- 4 Injury that could lead to a permanent disability
- 5 Injury that could lead to fatality

### Exposure/Probability Scale description - How often are you exposed to this hazard and/or how likely is to happen?

- 1 Person(s) exposed once every six months and/or injury improbable to happen
- 2 Person(s) exposed few times a month and/or injury unlikely to happen, though conceivable
- 3 Person(s) exposed few times a week and/or injury could happen sometimes
- 4 Person(s) exposed few times a day and/or injury very likely to happen
- 5 Person(s) exposed all day and/or injury expected to happen anytime
